2. Behavioral Analysis

✓ Geographic stability centered in Columbus metro area with consistent Franklin County presence over 15+ years. Multiple overlapping addresses during 2022-2025 period suggest transitional housing arrangements or strategic address usage during probation supervision. Phone continuity maintained through six active wireless numbers, indicating sustained communication access. Frequent apartment/multi-family dwelling occupancy with rotating co-residents suggests rental lifestyle and possible shared housing arrangements. No current vehicle registrations despite historical ownership of four vehicles (2003-2014), indicating reliance on alternative transportation or unregistered vehicle use.

3. Psychological Profile

✗ Pattern of escalating criminal behavior from petty theft (2011) to drug-related homicide (2020) indicates poor impulse control and high-risk decision-making. 8. Vehicles & Transportation

12. Final Thoughts

Subject represents extreme public safety risk with unresolved questions demanding immediate investigative attention. Primary concern: How is subject accessing weapons despite felony convictions and active probation? Courthouse weapon offense (2025) while under supervision for murder indicates brazen disregard for security protocols and suggests continued weapons access. Second priority: What is subject's current income source? No documented employment yet maintains multiple phone lines, housing, and vehicle access. Pattern suggests unreported income potentially from continued drug activity, given major possession conviction (20+ grams) in 2024. Third concern: Why multiple overlapping addresses during probation period? Strategic address usage may indicate evasion planning or compartmentalized criminal activity. Recommended actions: (1) Coordinate with Franklin County probation officer for compliance check and residence verification, (2) Conduct surveillance at mother's property (3914 Oakmont Dr) as primary family anchor point, (3) Monitor all six active phone numbers for pattern-of-life analysis, (4) Investigate husband Marcus Briggs for potential criminal involvement, (5) Request probation violation warrant based on continued criminal activity. Subject's escalation from theft to homicide combined with post-conviction weapons offense and major drug possession creates imminent danger scenario requiring immediate intervention.
